5. Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets. They are based on the SBTi definition of net zero in the expectation of 90% reduction, and 10% removal of residual emissions with the ambition to attain that goal by 2050 in line with government commitments.

We project that our within boundary Scope 1 and 2, & 3 emissions will reduce to 0.8 tCO₂e, 2.4 tCO₂e, and 183.8 tCO₂e respectively by 2028.

It is projected that overall carbon emissions will decrease over the next 5 years to 187 tonnes CO₂e/year. This is a reduction of 16.7% which reflects a linear decrease in emissions until the target date of net zero by 2050.

6. Progress against emissions reduction targets

It is our intention to update this report at least annually and deliver carbon reductions each year that combine to achieve our overall objective by 2050.

Predominantly due to the minimization of air transport we are currently ahead of our net zero trajectory.

7. Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

- Increased use of digital meetings to reduce business travel
- LED and PIR sensors in offices
- Purchased electric vehicle
- Company have developed a low weight, renewable materials based medical disposal vessel which provides customers with a more sustainable waste management product
- Reduction in air transport

8. Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
